The Institute of Foreign Languages at the Technical University in Zvolen and the Czech and Slovak Association of Language Centres invite you to a traditional autumn conference on applied languages and applied linguistics, providing the opportunity to exchange knowledge and experience among foreign language teachers at universities with philological and non-philological focus.

This year's conference draws attention also to teaching foreign languages in relation to the development of soft skills and communication in academic and professional contexts. In the foreground, foreign language education in philological and non-philological study programmes is linked to the needs of students from the aspect of their holistic personal development, considering the requirements of professional practice in the context of lifelong learning.

In addition, papers focused on various linguistic, literary, and terminological aspects of foreign language teaching are welcomed.

Papers passing the review process will be published in the peer-reviewed proceedings of scientific papers *Aplikované jazyky v univerzitnom kontexte XI*. Selected papers may be published in *Apps – Academic Journal of Applied Linguistics and Languages*.
