CONTEXT

The modern labour market is increasingly challenging, demanding, unpredictable and skill-intensive. Higher education institutions (HEIs) are expected to prepare graduates for the world of work. Knowledge of foreign languages is now viewed as a form of human capital that enhances an employee's performance and productivity in the workplace and, hence, contributes to value creation for an employer. LSP [Language for specific purposes] courses are frequently aimed at teaching the language connected to students' field of study. However, the needs of future employers need to be taken into consideration as well.

OBJECTIVES

The overarching goal of the **project LSP4Employability: Language Skills for Employable Graduates** has been to develop a course hand-in-hand with European partners to enhance the employability of graduates through implementing relevant e-Learning LSP teaching materials. These are designed and based on recommendations from employers, recruitment professionals, and experts in cross-cultural awareness drawn from each partner institution's educational, professional and employer networks.
